


MOTORHOME-PARK:: INFO

The following vehicles are permitted in the motorhome-park:



- » All vehicles that offer sleeping space for as many people as they are traveling in the vehicle (e.g., classic campers, converted buses, station wagons > if sleeping spaces are available) are permitted in the motorhome-park. Folding caravans are also considered caravans.
- **»** Driving the vehicle out of the motorhome-park and later re-entering is not permitted. Once parked, the vehicle/car must remain in the motorhome-park until departure.
- **»** Parking and staying overnight in motorhomes in the visitor parking lot or on the festival campground is not permitted. Vehicles may only be parked in the motorhome-park (hard surface only).
- **»** The motorhome tickets are personalized and limited to a maximum of 4 tickets per order.

» ARRIVAL

You can find directions and important information about how to get here on our homepage under the heading «ARRIVAL».

» ELECTRICITY

There are electrical distribution boxes at various locations in the motorhome-park (230V plugs). Each visitor is responsible for their own extension cord.

» GROUPS

If you want to camp together, you should arrive together. You cannot wait for each other at the entrance.

» OPENING HOURS «MOTORHOME-PARK»

The motorhome-park is open from **WEDNESDAY** 4 pm until **SUNDAY** 12 am.

Entry times :: Opening hours Cash desk / Exchange (Subject to change)

WEDNESDAY 15:00 – 22:00 h THURSDAY 09:00 – 22:00 h FRIDAY 09:00 – 22:00 h SATURDAY 10:00 – 20:00 H

Visitors arriving outside opening hours will be directed to the forecourt of Hall 2, where they will be parked until the exhibition opens the following day. Early arrivals will be charged a parking fee of CHF 20, which will be collected on site.

» PAVILION / TENTS

Maximum of 1 awning/pavilion permitted per motorhome pitch (max. 3 x 3 m).

Tents and motorhomes are separated! Apart from one awning/pavilion per motorhome, it is not permitted to pitch additional tents in the separate motorhome-park. **Please note:** The motorhome-park is located on hard ground!

» PRICE

Price per pitch: CHF 150

- » One ticket is required per vehicle and per trailer.
- » The number of places is limited, so please use the ticket pre-sale service.
- » The pitches at the motorhome-park are all on hard ground.
- » The motorhome tickets are personalized and limited to a maximum of 4 tickets per order.

The motorhome ticket includes the following services:

- Pitch for the entire duration of the festival
- Toilet facilities in the immediate vicinity
- Electricity connection is available;
 - » 1x 230V- Plug/connection per motorhome pitch
 - » Visitors are responsible for bringing their own extension cords (at least 50 m)

» SANITARY FACILITIES

Separate toilet facilities are available in the motorhome-park. The sanitary facilities at the festival campsite can be used for showering.

» SWIMMING

If you want to go swimming, visit the seaside resort in Bönigen (www.strandbadboenigen.ch) or Lake Brienz. Both are just under 2 kilometers from the festival grounds. Swimming and cooling off in the nearby Lütschine stream is PROHIBITED, as it is extremely dangerous! This also applies to the Lütschine delta at its confluence with Lake Brienz near Bönigen.

» WATHER

Water is only available at the general festival campsite. (Drinking water points are marked)

» FINALLY

HOUSE RULES :: MOTORHOME-PARK

The same rules apply to all campers/motorhomes as on the festival campsite:

ALLOWED / DO'S

- » Accessories with rivets and chains
- » Deodorant, hairspray, perfume in cans or bottles max. 100 ml containers
- » Skateboards, scooters
- » Mounts (handles, selfie sticks, tripods) for cameras/smartphones
- » MP3 players, iPods, Bluetooth speakers
- » Pocket and mini cameras (no interchangeable lenses)

Drinks

» PET, aluminum, Tetra Pak containers, and canisters— one-time max. 6 liters per person

Tools

- » Pocket knife
- » Hammer up to 300 g, rubber mallet up to 400 g all other types expressly prohibited!

Buildings / Furniture

- » Permanent installations in motorhomes/vehicles (such as heating) are permitted. **BUT** our regulations/rules apply to everything outside of permanent installations...
- » Max. 1 pavilion/awning per motorhome pitch (max. 3 x 3 m)
- » Camping equipment such as camping chairs/tables
- » Parasols up to max. 2 meters in diameter
- » Cooling boxes
- » Any type of «transport trolley» including green waste bins
- » Power stations and solar panels
- » All devices/equipment that are charged with solar batteries

NOT ALLOWED / DON'TS

- » All pyrotechnics, fireworks, firecrackers, smoke bombs, torches, etc.
- » Weapons of any kind, including striking, cutting, and thrusting weapons such as knives, axes, etc., as well as other dangerous objects pocket knives are permitted
- » Drugs of any kind this also applies to CBD
- » Spray cans of any kind deodorant and hairspray in containers of max. 100 ml are permitted
- » Animals of any kind
- » Bicycles and other wheeled objects (exception: festival management/staff)
- » Digital & analog SLR cameras, as well as video & film cameras with interchangeable lenses (Exception: Persons with accreditation)
- » Cartridge belts
- » Drones

Buildings / Furniture / Equipment

- » Permanent installations in motorhomes/vehicles (such as heating) are permitted. **BUT** our regulations/rules apply to everything outside of permanent installations ...
- » Furnishings like sofas, chairs, etc.
- » Bulky waste / building materials
- » Refrigerators and other kitchen appliances, kitchen knives, etc.
- » Disproportionate structures such as party tents
- » Gasoline-powered generators and/or power units, as well as car batteries of any kind
- » All types of gaseous, liquid, and solid oxidizing substances are prohibited dry ice is also prohibited!
- » All types of grills: gas grill, disposable grill, charcoal grill, electric grill, camping grill, etc.
- » Barbecuing is prohibited near tents and motorhomes separate barbecue area «Grillfield» available
- » Glass bottles & glass containers (exceptions: perfume in containers of max. 100 ml, jam jars)
